2. Biodiversity and food web research assistant

Intern responsibilities

- Sampling biodiversity in arid and hyper-arid ecosystems.
- Comparing sand dune, acacia woodland dry valleys, agriculture and other ecosystems.
- Building a desert food web structure using stable isotope analysis, cafeteria experiments, field sampling, behavioral observations and lab experiments.
- Sample soil fauna.
- Develop the detritus food web concept.
- Assist in collaboration with Jordanian researchers.
- Write reports and proposals.

3. LTSER Coordinator

Intern responsibilities

- Running the platform including updating scientists, website, budget, arranging meetings, writing research proposals, etc

- Developing the concept of ecosystem integrity.
- Ecosystem integrity field work both in the Arava (Israel and Jordan) and in the Negev.
- Developing the Arava natural history museum.
- Linking biodiversity to management and planning.
- Assisting in collaboration with Jordanian researchers.
